INVITATION

The Brazilian Orienteering Confederation (CBO), the Orienteering Federation of Goiás (FOG), the Entre Rios Orienteering Club (COER), and the Municipality of Ipameri are honored to invite the entire orienteering community to participate in the 26th Brazilian Orienteering Championship (26th CamBOr), which will be held from April 30 to May 4, 2025, in Ipameri, in the southeastern region of the state of Goiás.



Characterized by diverse vegetation, lush fauna, and a seasonal tropical climate with dry winters and rainy summers.

CERRADO VEGETATION

CLEAN FIELD

Vegetation composed of grasses, suitable for easy movement.



DIRTY FIELD

This type includes a mix of grasses and some scattered shrubs and small trees.

CERRADO (STRICTO SENSU)

Vegetation predominant in the Cerrado, characterized by a high incidence of shrub species and twisted trunks.





DRY FORESTS

Vegetation found far from watercourses, which loses its leaves during the dry season.

CERRADO VEGETATION

"CERRADÃO"

A dense form of the Cerrado, resembling a dry forest. It has a closed canopy of taller trees and a well-developed understory, with fewer grasses than the other types.





GALLERY FORESTS

Vegetation that follows watercourses, characterized by trees with smooth trunks and small leaves, which maintain their foliage throughout the year.

PALM GROVES

Vegetation of great exuberance, found in floodplain areas and located in the headwaters of various river basins.





ROCKY CERRADO

Vegetation formed in rocky environments, especially in mountain ranges.

IPAMERI

Ipameri, the city hosting the 26th CamBOr, is a typical and peaceful inland city. Its main attractions are:

FOUNTAIN PARK


Eight natural pools with hot water, reaching temperatures of up to 37.5°C.




EMBARGOED AREAS



- Participation in the IOF World Ranking Event (WRE) is mandatory for the M-W21 Elite categories.
- The date to be considered for the ranking freeze will be April 13, 2025, for the purposes of drawing up the starting lists.
- Elite athletes must register both on the IOF Eventor (IOF registration system) and on the CBO website.







The map scales and contour line intervals will follow the guidelines established by the current ROP/CBO.






MAPS



The competition will follow the IOF Rules for Foot Orienteering Competitions, the CBO Foot Orienteering Rules, and the CamBOr Regulations, all of which are in force at the time of the competition and available at: https://https://https.www.cbo.org.br/regras

According to rule 6.6 of the ROP, competitors participating in a race are responsible for any risks and accidents they may encounter while preparing for and executing the courses. Accident insurance is the responsibility of the athlete or the club to which they belong.

For safety reasons, it is recommended that elderly individuals, people with mobility difficulties, and deaf individuals carry a whistle with them during the course, to be used in case of emergencies.

Athletes participating in the event authorize the use of their images for the purposes of publicizing and promoting the sport.

Minor athletes need authorization from a guardian to participate in official events. <u>The form is available on the event website!</u>
