





## 04. RULES & REGULATIONS



The competition will follow the Rules of the International Orienteering Federation, the Brazilian Confederation, in particular, the Regulations of the Brazilian Sprint Orienteering Championships and the International Specifications for Sprint Orienteering Maps (ISSprOM/2019), all of which are available on the CBO website

This is an official CBO event and it is subject to doping control by the BRAZILIAN DOPING CONTROL AUTHORITY (ABCD).

## 05. CLASSES & UNIFORMS

The classes will comply with the IOF standard classes for elite (M/W21E) and CBO classes (Rule 2.1 / ROP 2024) for all other classes, summarized in the following tables:

a. Competitors must comply with the rules 2.2 and 2.3 of the ROP regarding the age group they fall into;

b. Rule 2.8 - Degree of difficulty "N" is not competitive, the main objective of which all beginners will be awarded medals, without distinction of classification, at the start of the awards ceremony;

c. For the uniforms, in accordance with Rule 126 of the RGOP/CBO, standardized numbers will be made for the athletes. The start line official will strictly observe the details described in the Rule, including prohibiting athletes with improvised numbers to start until they regularize their uniform, without the right to a new starting time.



## 06. ATHLETE'S LOGISTICS

The city of Fortaleza has several modes of transportation, food and lodging, available from nationally known app-based companies that will be used as a base so that they can easily get to the race venues, tourist attractions or other points of interest. Agreements to obtain discounts on these logistics (including CANTONMENT) will be published in subsequent bulletins. At the venues there will be minimal infrastructure (toilets and water) to welcome athletes.

The athlete will receive, after signing a receipt, all event material (04 Maps/Signage\*, SI-Card\* and bib numbers) according to the schedule.


*\* Rented SI-Cards and bib numbers will be initially available at the event secretariat, while the maps and loose description cards will only be handed out at the start of each race. Rented SI-Card must be returned to the registration office after the end of the last race.*



## 07. MAPS AND COURSES

All maps will be in accordance with ISSprOM/2019 (INTERNATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR SPRINT ORIENTEERING MAPS), and all details will be published in subsequent bulletins. The courses will take place in urban areas and will comply with ISSprOM/2019.

*\* The model event will be available for your choice at the time of registration at the CBO website, for the purposes of controlling people on site, and it will be made available free of charge to all registrants.*



## 08. TIMING AND RESULTS



SPORTident will be used for timing. Those athletes who have their own SI-Card must enter their numbers when registering for the event, so that they can be registered and checked in the SisCBO. Athletes who do not have their own SI-Card at the time of registration must pay a rental fee, which generates responsibility on the part of the competitor, who in the event of damage or loss of the rented SI-Card. In such case, upon return, the athlete/club must indemnify the CBO in the amount of R\$ 400.00 (four hundred reais).

Partial announcement of the results will be made via multimedia at the finish line and the official results will be posted in a specific place at the Event Centre, with subsequent publication on the CBO website.



## 09. AWARDS

It will be held in accordance with Art. 30 of the CamBOS Regulations. If any athlete cannot be present at the podium for justifiable reason, he/she must inform the Organizing Committee in advance, in accordance with the provisions of the Rule 161 of the RGOP/CBO. We recommend that athletes invited to the podium for awards should be in uniform according to CBO requirements, highlighting their uniforms, clubs and Orienteering Federations, as well as avoiding the use of large banners or flags, in order to respect the space of the other awarded athletes.
