The Brazilian Virtual Orientation Championship (CAMBOR Virtual 2020) is an event held by the Brazilian Orienteering Confederation - CBO, in five stages.

The 5th Stage will take place on October 10th 2020, from 15:00 to 20:00 (Brazilian) and will be organized by the Sao Paulo Orienteering Federation – FOSP.

CAMBOR Virtual 2020 will be held through online challenges, with multiple choice questions, about Sport Orientation, in pedestrian mode and precision guidance. Anyone may participate, regardless of whether or not they are affiliated with the CBO.

5. TECHNICAL INFORMATIONS

5.1 – Participation

The event is opened for all people, orienteering athletes or beginners.

5.2 – Classes

The event will be divided into two classes – Expert and Beginner.

5.3 – About the Challenges

- a) The participant will have a maximum period of 01 (one) hour and 30 minutes to complete the challenges of the event.
- b) The event will be opened at 15:00 and closed at 20:00, on 10/10/2020 (Saturday).
- c) A link will be made available for athletes to have access to the training form, with questions similar to those that will make up the official competition, from 09/27/2020.

- d) Questions with different degrees of difficulties will be presented for the BEGINNER and EXPERIENCED class;
- e) The themes to be addressed:
 - Exercises about competition rules
 - Questions about using the compass and measuring distances
 - Climbing identification and relationship between contour lines
 - Questions about description of control points
 - Exercises to identify map or course errors
 - Exercises for comparing legs
 - Exercises to identify real photos with map sectors
 - Questions about ISOM 2017-2 (International Specifications for Orienteering Maps) and ISSprOM 2019 (International Specifications for Sprint Orienteering Maps)
 - Videos of Orienteering courses (video game Virtual Orienteering) containing small sections of navigation where the participant must identify the displacement made on the map;
 - Trail Orienteering techniques using :
 - Photos of the land with up to 5 "identified" flags from A to E, from left to right, plus a map of the area containing a circle indicating the location of the control, with signs and a northern arrow.
