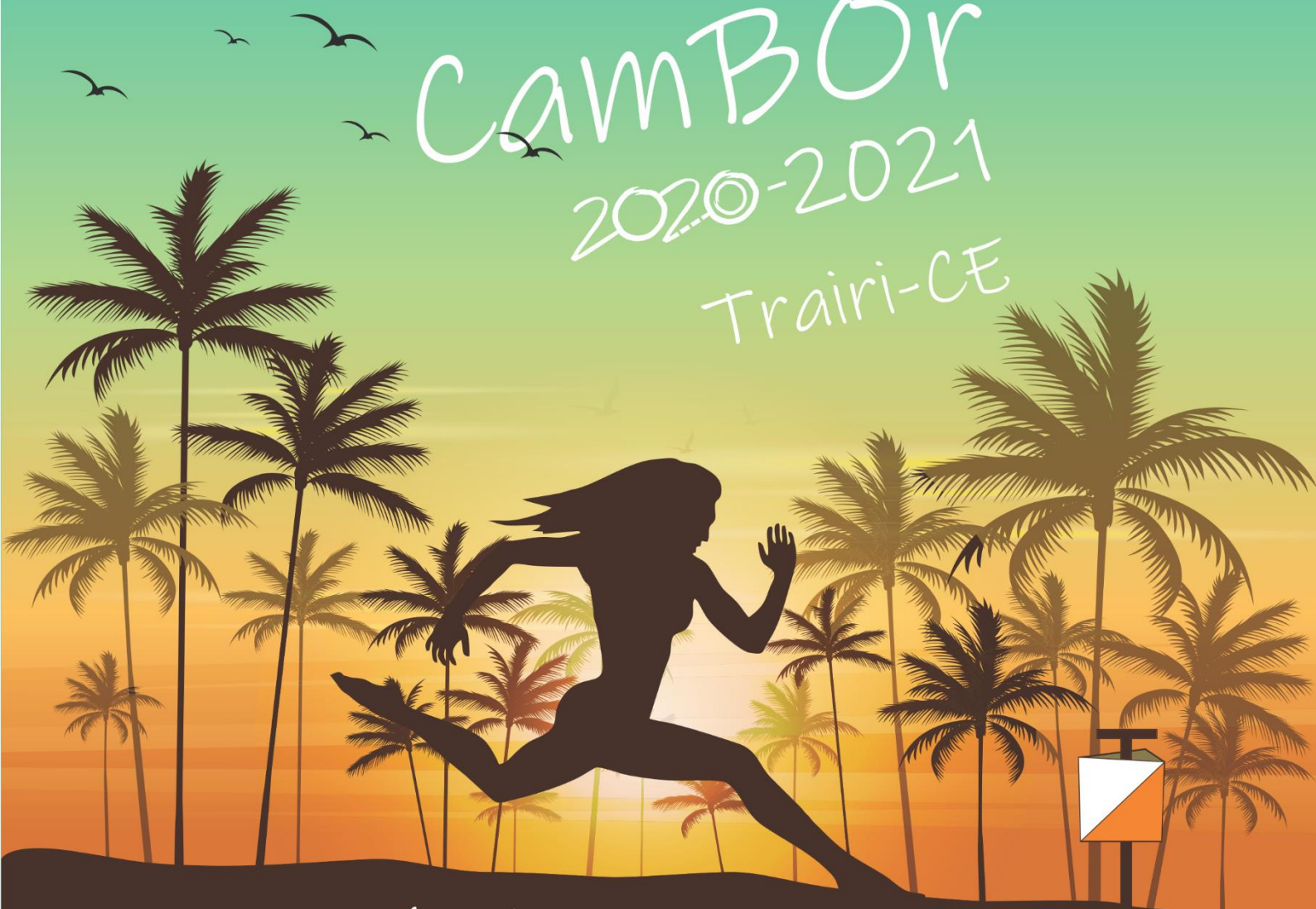

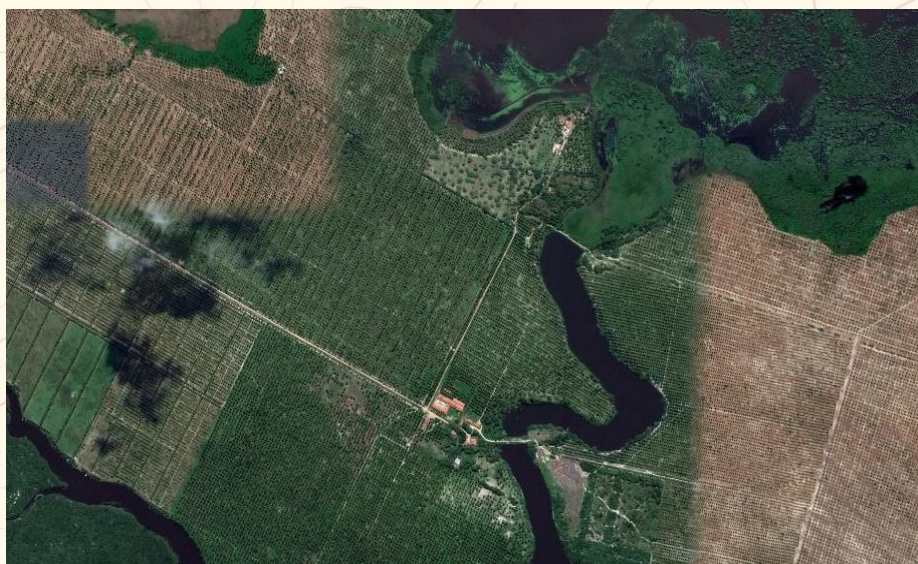

## LAND DESCRIPTION

### DESCRIPTION OF AREAS

#### FOREST COURSES

Fazenda Bom will house both forest-style events.

Throughout this farm, the cultivation of coconut palms predominates, in an area of around 2,600ha, intersected by lagoons. There are few and passable fences. There is a small incidence of cattle, sheep and donkeys.

The entire area takes on the typical characteristics of Restinga - proximity to the beach - with sandy terrain and dune undulations at maximum elevations of 40m, in relation to sea level.

In the long-distance course, a peculiarity is added: an area of native forest, typical of restingas, with a greater occurrence of elongated dunes in sequence, interspersed with lagoons and having a predominant riparian vegetation of cashew trees.

In the middle course, a shrubby vegetation of up to 5m high predominates, between the coconut grove, intersected by streams and with little difference. There is a significant manifestation of muricizeiros, who open natural corridors, as well as several and indistinct trails marked by the passage of animals.

There is an expectation of a good rainy season. The region has an average temperature of 27°C.

#### RELAY AND SPRINT COURSES:

They have similar characteristics, in the friendly and welcoming villages of Guajiru and Mundaú, respectively. Both by the sea. They offer challenging alleys in unevenness that do not exceed 20m.

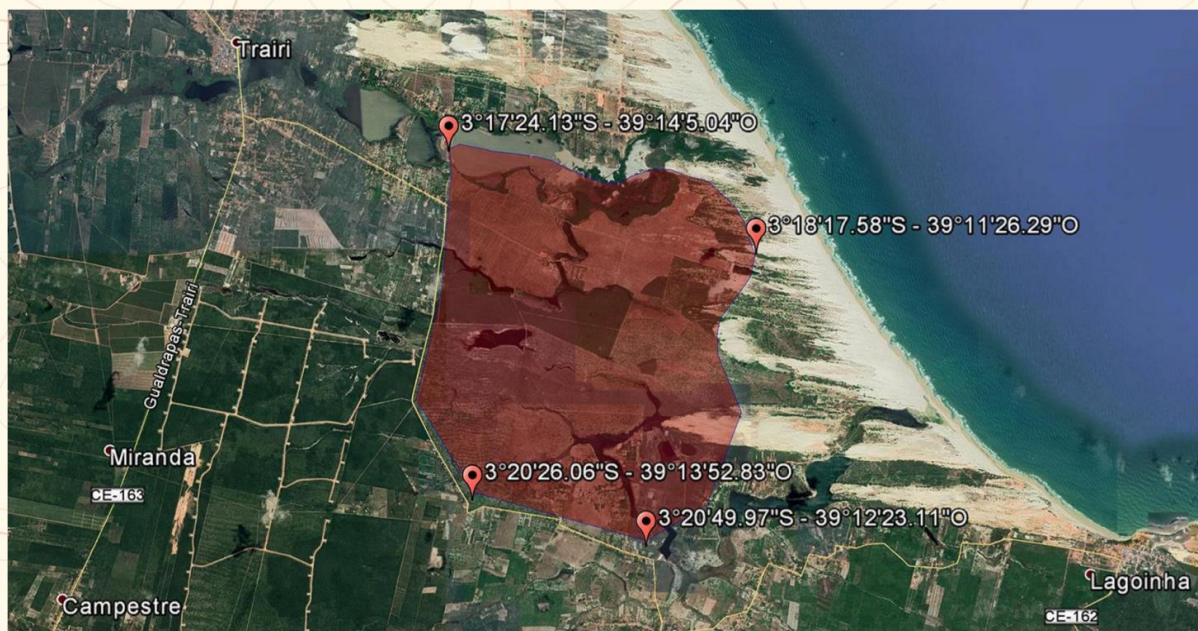

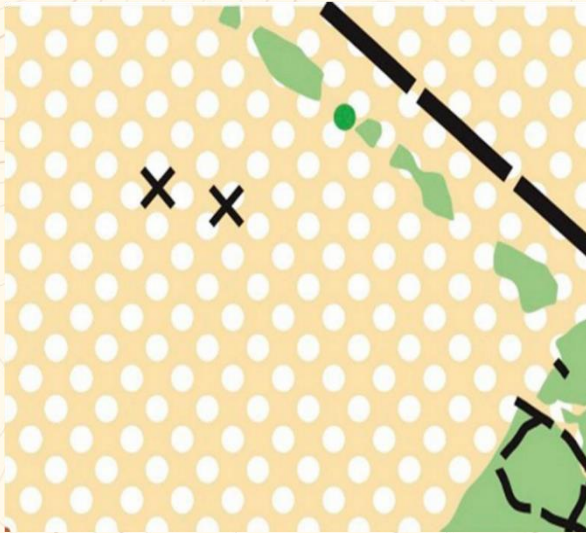


114 – Very uneven ground (ISOM 2017)



– Area of disposal of coconut shells



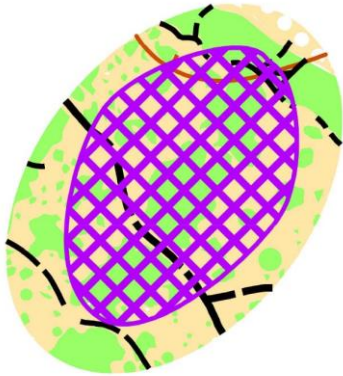


404 – Semi-open area with sparse trees (ISOM 2017) – Open coconut



**Attention:** Type of anthill and termite nest found in the competition area. They are flat objects less than 1m high.

**Attention:** Respect risk areas (apiaries - bees) that have been marked with the symbol: **Out of Test Area**.

**Comments:**

- Occurrence of thorny shrubs in all testing areas and nettles in only a small area of the long course.
- Occurrence of donkey and bovine animals (on the Long and Medium Routes), cause the appearance of new trails, formed overnight.

**ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD**

**CANTONMENT**

Two (2) schools were made available for the Cantonment of athletes, in Mundaú District (place of the Sprint Route): Colégio Zefinha Ribeiro Barroso and Escola Saturnino Lopes do Prado.

The canteen of the schools will offer a modest breakfast option, against payment, and the arrangement must be made directly between the interested party and the administration of the Cantina, when they arrive at the School.

## MAPS SCALES AND EQUIDISTANCE AND ESTIMATED TIME FOR WINNERS

Long route map:

- Scale 1:15,000, for Elite WRE, with a length between 8.3km to 10.6km with a difference in level between 230m and 265m; and
- Scales of 1:10,000 and 1:7,500 according to Rule 87, for other categories, with a length between 2.2km to 9.3km.

The equidistance between the level curves (CN) is 5m;

Average route map:

- Scale of 1:10,000 and 1:7,500 according to Rule 88, with a length between 1.8km to 4.8km.
- The equidistance between the level curves (CN) is 5m;

Sprint route map:

- Scale of 1:4,000 according to Rule 89, with an extension between 1km to 3.6km.
- The equidistance between the level curves (CN) is 2.5m.

PreO route map:

- Scales of 1:4,000, with CN of 2.5m.

## MAPS

The maps of the LONG and MEDIUM routes will be in the ISOM 2017 standard, version 2018.

The maps of the SPRINT and PreO routes will be in the ISprOM 2019 standard.



## SPORTIDENT SYSTEM

The SportIdent System bases will be programmed to reliably relate to all versions of SICARDs, such as: 8, 9, 10, 11, COMCARD (compass-coupled) and SIAC. The SIAC can be used both in DRILLING mode (touch) and in TIMER mode (no touch).

## FOREST TRAILS

From the parking place to the Start of the Long and Medium Distances, it is necessary for athletes to travel on foot in the following distances:

Long Route:

- Athletes in the Novato, Bravo categories ..... 800m
- Athletes in the Elite and Alpha categories..... 1.900m

Medium route:

- All athletes, on the way..... 1.500m
- All athletes, on the way back..... 1.500m

Important: It is necessary to consider the travel time to the starting point so that the athlete does not incur delays.

## PreO COURSE

The PreO Route will be available for two days, depending on the event's schedule. The athlete can choose to do it on Friday, from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm or on Saturday, from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Athletes who take the course on the first day must maintain CONFIDENTIALITY.

## WORLD RANKING EVENT - WRE

- • Freezing of the ranking for the purpose of starting order: 10/30/2021;
- • Athletes not registered in the WRE ranking will depart before and subject to the normal draw in the scoring system, in both courses;
- • The best in the WRE ranking of the respective course will leave at the end;
- • The order of the Medium course among WRE athletes will be in inverse order of the best results of the Long course. The organization, in a timely manner, may change this order to avoid distortions.



## HEALTH PROTOCOL

The "Protocol of Return of Guidance Activities", published on the CBO website, will be applied, in compliance with prevention/protection measures against COVID-19, particularly measures related to the use of masks and social distancing.

**Note:** Only during the courses will not be required to wear a mask.

## AWARDS

There will be an award at the end of the Sprint Course and the Forest Courses (Long and Medium). The award will accompany the dissemination of results.

**All athletes will receive participation medals.**

## TRANSFER

Buses will be made available for transportation to the competition venues, upon payment of a one-time fee of R\$ 15.00 per athlete, valid for the 3 (three) days of competitions.

The option for the transfer can be done by registering on the website, until November 10th. Those registered for the transfer will receive an identification bracelet to access the buses. After November 10th, the bracelet can only be purchased at the event's secretariat.

## OUTROS

- All registered athletes must receive a Kit with the event material at the event secretariat, also containing technical and administrative sketches.
- The Secretariat will be mobile, being present at test locations for storing volumes.
- The holding of the CBO General Assembly, to which everyone is invited, is an indirect part of the event. It will be held at the Pousada Mundaú hall, at 6 pm on 11/12/2021, right after the Sprint Route.
