4. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

- a. Anyone can participate, being an orienteering athlete or not, affiliated or not to orienteering Clubs.
- b. The Event will be played in the categories: **Beginner and Experienced**, with distinction by sex (H Beginner and D Beginner; H Experienced and D Experienced) and without distinction by age.
- c. The competition challenges will be divided into difficulty degrees:
 - **Easy** (Beginner category);
 - **Difficult** (Experienced category).
- d. Questions with challenges involving the following will be presented:
 - Orienteering videos;
 - Orienteering maps with courses;
 - Images and photographic survey;
 - Google Earth and Google Maps images;
 - Precision Orienteering Techniques;
 - Questions about ISOM 2017-2 (International Specifications for Orienteering Maps);
 - ISSprOM 2019 Questions (International Specifications for Sprint Guidance Maps).
- e. The challenges proposed in each question of the test will have values in points according to the degree of difficulty.
- f. At the end of the counting, we will have a ranking in numerical order of the participants according to the degree of correct answers.
- g. The **time factor**, that the athlete took to perform the course will be used in case of a tie for athletes with the same number of points.
- h. The participant will have a maximum period of 1 (one) hour and 30 minutes to complete the course.
- i. The course will **open at 4 pm and closed at 8 pm on 08/08/2020 (Saturday)**. After 8 pm the start of a course will no longer be accepted.
