BRAZILIAN CHAMPIONSHIP OF ORIENTERING CAMBOR 2020-2021

RISK AND SAFETY MANAGEMENT PLAN

1. PURPOSE

The Ceará Orienteering Federation (FECORI) presents the Risk and Safety Management Plan for the 2020-2021 Brazilian Orienteering Championship, which will take place in the city of Trairi, State of Ceará, aiming at disciplining logistical procedures aimed at preserving health and integrity participating athletes.

The concurrent legal basis for achieving this purpose is Rule 42 of the regulatory charter:

“Rule 42- Competitors taking part in a race are responsible for the risks and accidents they may suffer when traveling, concentrating and executing their courses. Accident insurance is the responsibility of the athlete or the club to which he belong”

Likewise, volunteers and all personnel engaged in the organization are responsible for the risks and accidents that they may suffer while traveling and in the places where the various activities that are part of the event take place.

In early September 2021, an assessment should be made, taking into account the determinations of governmental and local authorities, in order to decide on the applicability of the “**Security Protocol**”, for return for Orienteering activities, published on the CBO Website, in compliance with prevention and protection against **COVID-19**.

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2. EVENT INSTITUTION

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The Brazilian Orienteering Confederation (CBO), now represented in the State of Ceará, by the Ceará Orienteering Federation (FECORI), aims to disseminate, promote, regulate, determine and practice Orienteering sport in the Brazilian State.

3. TECHNICAL SHEET OF THE EVENT

3.1. SETTING: Municipality of Trairi, State of Ceará.

3.2. ORGANIZING FEDERATION: FECORI

3.3. PERIOD: November 11 to 14, 2021.

3.4. PROGRAMMING

The schedule is described in the Competition Bulletin published on the website <https://www.cbo.esp.br/evento/700> comprising all official activities, where the security management team will be mediating with the heads of the other teams, the planning logistical of the organization's activities regarding the assembly, verification and disassembly of courses; ordering the starting, finishing, counting and feeding environments; extraordinary actions related to the reception of the audience and others more that are in the process of definition. The security management team must monitor the related activities, from the day before the start of the competition until the day after its end.

4. GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE ENVIRONMENT

The competition environment consists of inhabited areas, allotments, virgin forest and farms that will be added to the maps used in the competition. The location facilitates the work of the security manager with regard to operational mobility in case of accidents involving the participants.

The history of the environment related to incidents with flora and fauna does not pose risks in the absence of official numbers that create preventive processes for the competition organizers. As for hydrography, we have numerous lake formations, however with predictable routes defined by the event's map manager.

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The access routes to the municipality hosting the event and districts are:

- Follow CE 085 / Km 00 (State Road Traffic Inspection Post in the Municipality of Caucaia) to the Road Junction at CE 085 / Km 114 (Gualdrapas District / Municipality of Trairi) with CE163. From there, follow the CE163 for 12 Km to the headquarters of the Municipality of Trairi.
- Departing from the headquarters of the municipality of Trairi and following the CE163, there are 18 Km (District of Guajiru), 14 Km (District of Flecheiras) and 18 Km (District of Mundaú).

The Military Police Headquarters responsible for the area is commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Mário Clézio Alves de Moura, who has already been properly informed, with new visits planned for the event's environment in the two previous weekends. On the days of the event, he will be supporting with ostentatious teams.

The nearest Fire Department Headquarters is Itapipoca, which will support us in extraordinary situations, already duly informed by the Event Director.

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5. RISK AND SECURITY MANAGEMENT

Security Actions are programmed as follows:

5.1 TRAINING COURSE

November 11, 2021, Thursday, 08:00 pm to 16:00 pm

Location: Mangaíba

- **Characteristics:**

- Training will take place in the Mangaíba area, where we find coconut trees, shrub vegetation up to 5 meters high, interspersed with native forests, similar to the areas of the Medium and Long distance routes;
- Special care must be taken with the markings and the demarcation of the athletes' parking área;
- In this Training, the main safety concern will be with the effects of flora on participants, particularly those arising from contacts with thorny plants (nettle, “cansanção”, etc.), which cause a burning sensation to the touch with the skin;
- As is normal in localities, during the course of the journey, the athletes may be sporadically disturbed by the approach and by barking of dogs, without major consequences.

- **Scheduled Action**

- Guide the signs on the access roads and the parking place;
- Awareness of the local community;
- Predict and provide antiallergic drugs for use by the first aid team;

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- Designate fixed and mobile teams to monitor the safety of the routes.
- Ambulance location: Maps delivery point (as long as it is not used for assistance).

5.2 PreO COURSE

November 12, 2021, Friday, 8:00 am to 12:00 pm

November 13, 2021, Saturday, 8:00 am to 15:00 pm

Location: Flecheiras Beach

- **Characteristics:**

- The competition will take place on the highway and on the streets, as well as on the waterfront of the District of Flecheiras;
- On the highway, there is the traffic of low intensity vehicles, with speeds above 40 Km / h;
- On the pavement streets, there is the traffic of medium intensity vehicles, considering the days of the week - Friday and Saturday - when the competition will be held;
- The main safety concern on this route will be with traffic on the paved road, seeking to reduce the speed of motor vehicles. Therefore, traffic control agents will be made available for this work.
- As is normal in localities, during the course of the course, athletes may occasionally be disturbed by the approach and by barking of dogs, without major consequences;

- **Scheduled Action**

- Placing speed reducers on the paved road, before and after the area used by athletes; using support staff;
- Beacons at the busiest points, on the main avenue of the town;

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- Awareness of the local community;
- Designate fixed and itinerant teams to monitor the safety of the routes, with the support of the Municipal Guard.
- Ambulance location: Event Center (as long as it is not used for assistance).

5.3 SPRINT COURSE

November 12, 2021, Friday, 14:30 pm to 17:30 pm

Location: Mundaú Beach

- **Characteristics:**

- The competition will take place on the streets, alleys, alleys, lanes and paths, as well as on the waterfront of the District of Mundaú;
- On the pavement streets, there is the traffic of low intensity vehicles, considering the day of the week - Friday when the competition will be held;
- The main safety concern on this route will be with the circulation of motor vehicles;
- As is normal in localities, during the course of the course, athletes may occasionally be disturbed by the approach and by barking of dogs, without major consequences.

- **Scheduled Action**

- Beacons at the points of greatest movement;
- Awareness of the local community;
- Designate fixed and itinerant teams to monitor the safety of the routes, with the support of the Municipal Guard.
- Ambulance location: Leisure Polo Square (as long as it is not used for care).

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5.5 LONG DISTANCE COURSE

November 13, 2021, Saturday, 8:00 am to 14:00 pm

Location: Fazenda Bom

- **Characteristics:**

- The competition will take place in the Fazenda Bom area, where coconut trees, native forests and shrub vegetation up to 5 meters high predominate, intersected by streams;
- Special care must be taken with the access markings and the demarcation of the athletes' parking area.
- In this Route, there is a concern for safety with the effects of flora on the participants, particularly those resulting from contacts with thorny plants (nettle, "cansanção", etc.), which cause the sensation of burning when touched with the skin;
- The fauna can also cause problems on the way (bees, ferocious dogs and etc.); as well as wet passages, ponds, rivers and other adverse situations.

- **Scheduled Action**

- Guide the signs on the access roads and the parking place;
- Awareness of the local community;
- Predict and make available antiallergic drugs and for stings of bees and venomous animals, to be used by the first aid team;
- Demarcate the areas of incidence of bees that are identified;
- Designate fixed and mobile teams to monitor the safety of the routes.
- Ambulance location: Athletes' concentration site, at Fazenda Bom headquarters (as long as it is not used for care).

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5.6 MEDIUM DISTANCE COURSE

November 14, 2021, Sunday, 8:00 am to 12:00 pm

Location: Fazenda Bom

- **Characteristics:**

- The competition will take place in the Fazenda Bom area, where coconut trees, native forests and shrub vegetation up to 5 meters high predominate, intersected by streams;
- Special care must be taken with the access markings and the demarcation of the athletes' parking area;
- In this Route, there is a concern for safety with the effects of flora on the participants, particularly those resulting from contacts with thorny plants (nettle, "cansação", etc.), which cause the sensation of burning when touched with the skin;
- Bees and dogs may also cause problems along the way;
- Wet passages, ponds, rivers and other adverse situations deserve safety attention.

- **Scheduled Action**

- Guide the signs on the access roads and the parking place;
- Awareness of the local community;
- Predict and make available antiallergic drugs and for stings of bees and venomous animals, to be used by the first aid team;
- Demarcate the areas of incidence of bees that are identified;
- Designate fixed and mobile teams to monitor the safety of the routes.
- Ambulance location: Place of concentration of athletes, at Fazenda Bom headquarters (as long as it is not used for care).

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5.7 AMBULANCE RESERVE

- In addition to the ambulance that will directly attend each event, the ambulance of the City Hall of Trairi will remain at the Municipal Hospital of Trairi, as a reserve, able to attend any emergencies, if the ambulance designated for direct support is being used.

6. SECURITY TEAM

Security Actions will be performed by the security team with the features described below:

6.1. SECURITY MANAGER

- Coordinate the event security support teams to guarantee the physical integrity of the event participants;
- Supervise the environments involved in the event, regarding safety, hygiene and health conditions;
- Accompany the Precursion Team in the assembly of the plotted routes and check the conditions close to the event, with the authority of veto of plots in case of observance of adversities;
- Accompany the Logistics Team in the provision of hydration and food structures in all environments involved in the event, with authority to collect food inappropriate for the use of athletes;
- Reception and supervise the equipment available, qualification and other points contracted by the Club with the team of Relief and Urgency;
- Release the Event Director to start the event after checking and approving the security conditions involved in the event;
- Activate the emergency and emergency assistance to the participants of the sporting event;

- Monitor the attendance at nosocomios registered in this security plan, or indicated by the athlete;
- Release the Precursion Team to dismantle the courses, immediately after, authorization from the Technical Director of the Event;
- Release the Logistics Team to collect the hydration and food structures, soon after, authorization from the Technical Director of the Event;
- Issue a detailed report of the activities performed at the event and a catalog of accidents that occurred for future prevention work.

6.2 DEPUTY SECUTITY MANAGER

- Assist the Event Security Manager and replace him in his absence.

6.3. PRECURSOR TEAM (05 MEMBERS)

- Assembly of the routes plotted and check the conditions close to the event, informing the Security Manager in case of observance of adversities.

6.4. LOGISTICS TEAM (05 MEMBERS)

- Installation of hydration and food structures in all environments involved in the event, informing the Safety Manager in the event of adverse events.

6.5. RELIEF AND URGENCY TEAM (05 MEMBERS)

- Assistance and emergency assistance to participants of the sporting event.

7. SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES

The security actions follow the schedule below:

November 04 and 05, 2021: Visit to the test site for adjustments to the map layout and interaction with the local community and authorities.

November 08 and 09, 2021: Visitation to the test site for labeling the plotted points; positioning of precursion teams and monitoring of feeding and hydration points.

November 12, 2021 (Sprint and PreO Course):

08h: Inspection of the test sites to update the points plotted and security conditions.

09h: Assembly of Arrival and Departure Structures.

11h: Check of the Hydro Sanitary Installations arranged.

11h: Conference on Conditioning of Food and Hydration.

November 13 and 14, 2021 (PreO, Medium and Long Distance Course):

06h: Installation of the plotted points and check of security conditions.

06h: Installation of feeding and hydration points and checking of safety conditions.

07h: Release of the race track for athletes.

08h-14h: Monitoring the functionalities of subordinate teams.

14h: Uninstalling the plotted points, feeding and hydration.

In cases of accident occurrences, the security manager must travel to the location of the incident with the available emergency and emergency service or, in the event of greater severity, direct the displacement to the determined nosocomio. In the event of a fatal accident, adopt the legal measures provided for in the Criminal Procedure Code.

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In specific claims involving individuality (allergies and others), the security manager must proceed to the previous interview with the victim or with relatives, in case of impossibility of carrying out, always guaranteeing the athlete's physical integrity.

8. FINAL CONSIDERATIONS

The plan was approved by Referee Sergio Gonçalves Brito, and must now be disseminated to the organization of the event.

Any situations not duly clarified should be decided by the Event Security Manager and, if it persists, by the Event Director will ultimately demand the matter.
