INVITATION

The Brazilian Orienteering Confederation (CBO) and the Orienteering Federation of the Federal District (FODF) have the honor to invite everyone to participate in the 13th Cerrado Orienteering Trophy (TCO), 2026 edition, which will take place from October 10 to 12, 2026, in Brasília, Federal District, an event counting towards the International Orienteering Federation World Ranking.

1. GOLD WORLD RANKING EVENT

The Gold World Ranking Event (Gold WRE) is a new event status introduced by the International Orienteering Federation (IOF) in 2026, introducing the status of **Gold World Ranking Event**, as an important step to strengthen elite competition and support athletes worldwide. This designation highlights the most prestigious events, providing high-quality terrain, greater visibility, and strong competition, contributing to athlete preparation for major IOF events. 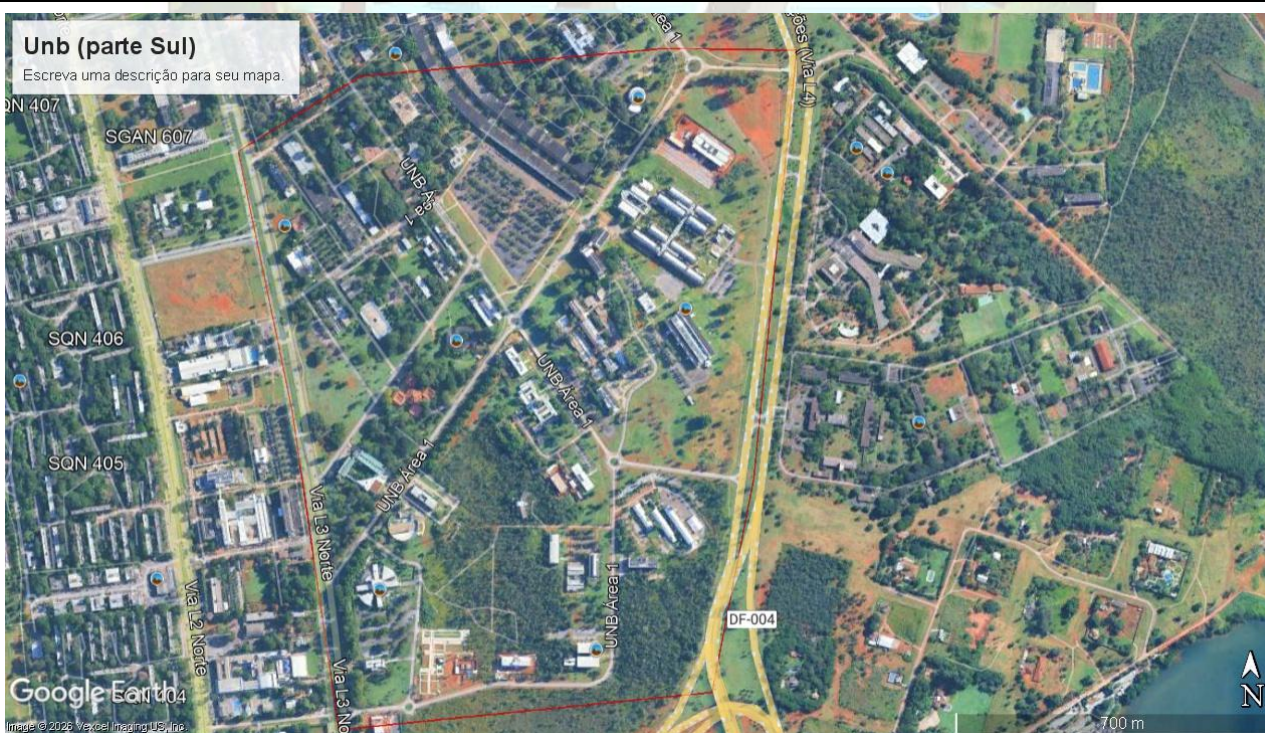

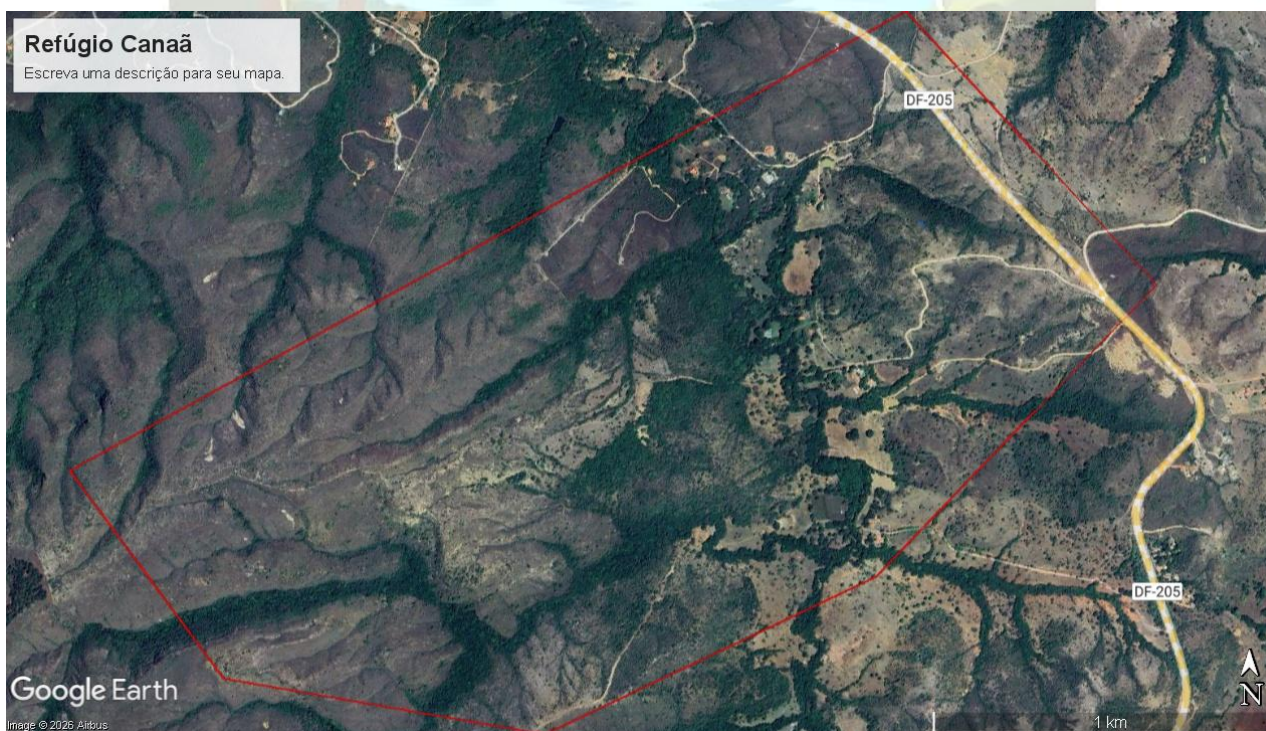

11. ACCOMMODATION

- Brazilian athletes residing outside the Federal District may also be eligible for support, subject to availability.

13. FINAL REMARKS

- All participants must have valid personal insurance; affiliated athletes should verify their insurance coverage.
- Training opportunities may be offered under the immersion program.
- The average temperature during the event period is approximately 26°C, ranging from 20°C to 32°C (**from 68° to 89.6°F**).
